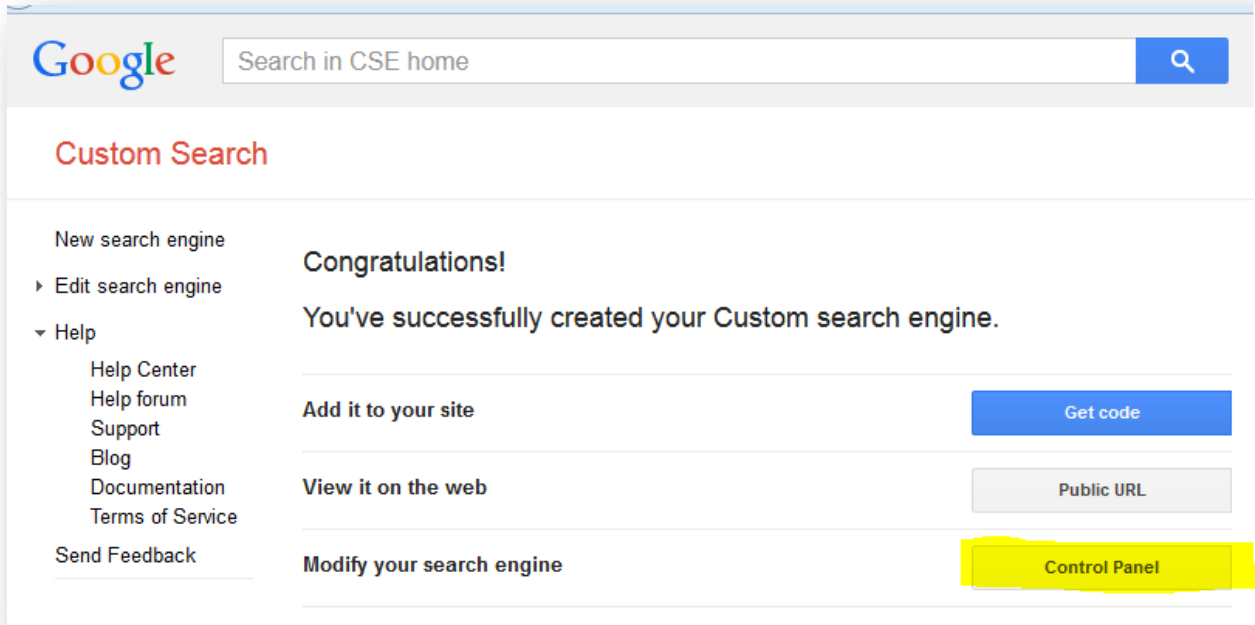


Setting up a Google Custom Search

1. Navigate to www.google.com/cse
2. Click on 'New Search Engine'
3. Fill out the information. In sites to search, add a /* to the end of your domain.

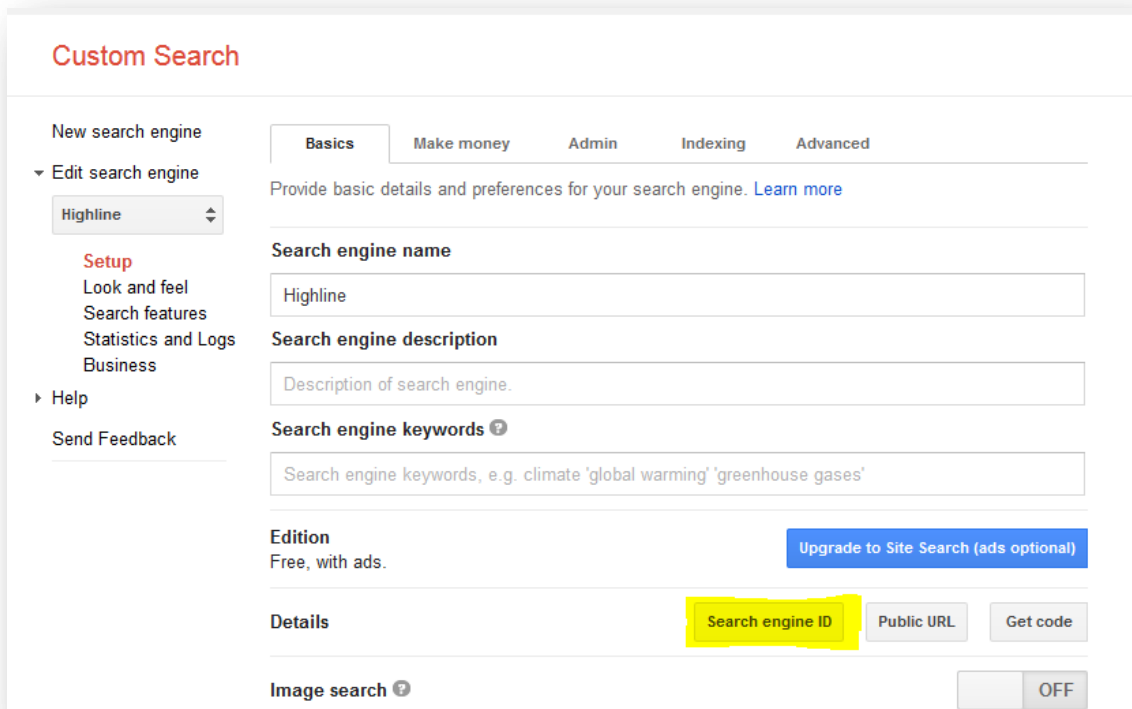

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To place the ID in Site Manager:

1. Click on 'System Settings' under 'Configure'.
2. Click on the 'Integration' tab.
3. Change the search engine type to 'Google'.
4. Paste the Search Engine ID in the field provided.
